Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 40-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM
Section 30; SW/4 NE/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Vivian Well No. 2, located 1980 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line of said Section 30.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-1670, as amended, governing the Blinebry Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 40 acres.

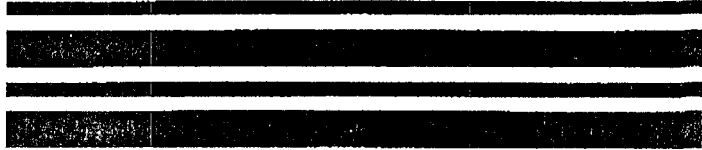
This order shall be effective the date an oil well allowable was assigned to your Vivian Well No. 4, located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line of said Section 30.

Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation respectfully requests administrative approval of a Non-Standard 40-Acre Blinebry Gas Proration Unit covering the SW/4 NE/4 Section 30, Township 22 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico. This Non-Standard Unit is to be attributed to the Vivian Well No. 2. In support of this application the following facts are submitted:

- (1) Applicant's Vivian Well No. 2, located 1980 feet from the north and east lines of Section 30, is classified as a Blinebry Gas well and is shut-in with the SW/4 NE/4 being dedicated to the Vivian Well No. 4 for Blinebry Gas production.
- (2) Applicant's Vivian Well No. 4, located 1980 feet from the north line and 660 feet from the east line of Section 30, has been reclassified as a Blinebry Oil well.
- (3) The proposed Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit consists of a quarter-quarter section within a single governmental quarter section.
- (4) The entire Non-Standard Gas Proration Unit is reasonably presumed to be gas productive in the Blinebry Gas Pool.
- (5) The length or width does not exceed 2640 feet.
- (6) All Operators in the quarter section in which the proposed Non-Standard Unit is located and within 1500 feet of the Unit Well have been furnished a copy of this application.

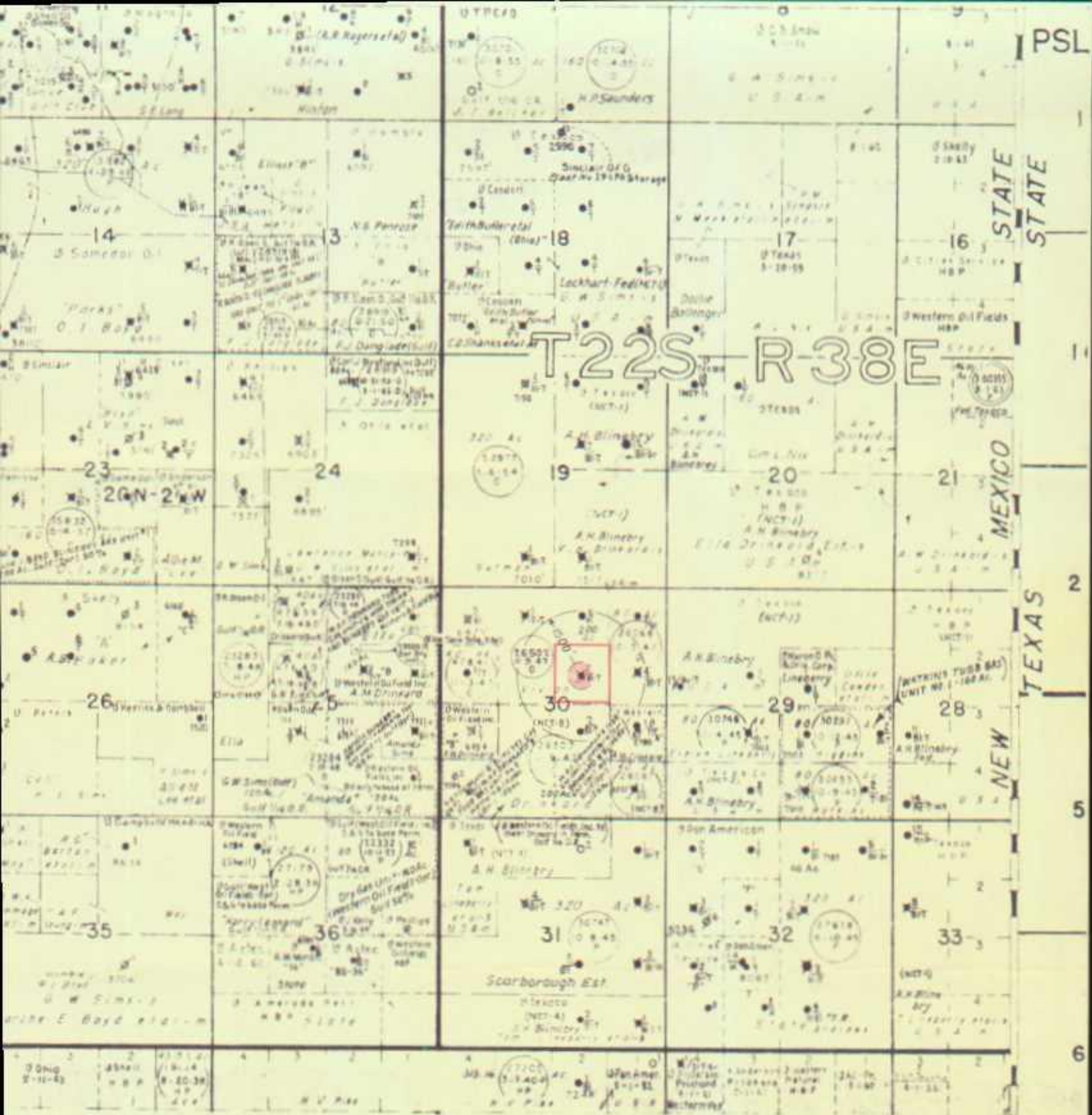
