Gentlemen:

This will confirm our conversation with Mr. C. L. Whigham on March 24, 1964, concerning your application for a 126.18-acre non-standard proration unit in the Tubb Gas Pool, to be dedicated to the above well.

Your application is not eligible for administrative approval as part of the acreage does not lie within a single governmental quarter section and the unit will exceed 2640 feet. It therefore will be necessary to hold a hearing before the request may be granted. However, we will treat the application as a request for a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Tubb Gas Pool consisting of the N/2 and SW/4 of the SE/4 of Section 33 and issue an order approving the same upon receipt of waivers from offset operators or expiration of the 30-day waiting period. We will docket a hearing to add the additional 6.18 acres upon your request.

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 126.18-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Tubb Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM
Section 33: Lot 3 and W/2 SW/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your A. H. Blinebry NCT-1 Well No. 16, located 2022 feet from the south line and 660 feet from the West line of said Section 33.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-1670, as amended, governing the Tubb Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 126.18 acres.
