Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 677.16-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO  
TOWNSHIP 22 SOUTH, RANGE 23 EAST, NMPM  
Section 3: All

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Bogle Flats Unit Well No. 1, located 1953 feet from the North line and 1650 feet from the East line of said Section 3.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-2440 governing the Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 677.16 acres.
