This is the application of Standard Oil Company of Texas for exception to Rule 2 of the operating rules for the Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, for the Bogle Flats Unit No. 1 well. This well is located in Section 3, Township 22 South, Range 23 East, as shown on the attached plat.

Rule 2 provides for a standard unit consisting of 640 acres consisting of a single governmental section. Rule 3 provides for administrative exception to Rule 2 when an unorthodox unit size is necessitated by a variation in the legal subdivision of the United States Public Lands Survey. Such variation is the case here, with Section 3 consisting of 677.16 acres.
