Gentlemen:

The undersigned hereby requests the Oil Conservation Commission to approve the pooling for communitization of fractional lot 6, comprising 6.92 acres, with the southeast quarter (SE/4) of the southwest quarter (SW/4), both tracts being in Section 4, Township 24 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico. In this connection, the undersigned applicant submits the following:


1. Three (3) copies of a certified plat showing the dimensions of the acreage involved;
2. As appears from the enclosed plats, the two tracts are contiguous;
3. Both tracts are covered by the same basic lease, being State of New Mexico Lease No. K-4565;
4. Both tracts are subject to the same royalty interest and the undersigned is the owner of the entire leasehold interest in both tracts. The only person or firm owning leases offsetting the tracts in question, other than the undersigned, is the Standard Oil Company of Texas, a Division of the Chevron Oil Company. That firm has been furnished with a copy of this application.

5. Seco Production Company, an operating company, wholly owned by applicant, is currently drilling a well, the Crawford-State No. 1, located 660' from the east line of Lot 6 and 660' from the south line of the southeast quarter (SE/4) of the southwest quarter (SW/4). It should be completed in the Ellenburger formation within two weeks from this date.



Gentlemen:

Under the date of August 6, 1965, I wrote the Oil Conservation Commission requesting approval of a non-standard unit comprising Lot 6 and the southeast quarter (SE/4) of the southwest (SW/4) quarter of Section 4, Township 24 North, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico. Subsequently I received notice of the order of the Commission in Case No. 3279 (R-2944) establishing temporary rules for the Stateline Ellenburger Field. This order requires that each well be located on eighty acres.

In view of the requirements of the Commission's order R-2944, I wish to withdraw the previous request and in lieu thereof now ask the Commission to approve the pooling for communitization of fractional lots 5 and 6 and the east half (E/2) of the southwest quarter (SW/4) of Section 4, Township 24 South, Range 38 East, Lea County, New Mexico.

Enclosed are three copies of a certified plat showing the dimensions of the acreage involved. As appears from the plats, the four tracts are contiguous.

All tracts are covered by the same basic lease, being State of New Mexico No. 4565. The basic royalty is of course the same on all tracts and the undersigned is the owner of the entire leasehold interest in all tracts.



The undersigned is currently drilling a well located 660' from the east line of lot 6 and 660' from the south line of the southeast quarter (SE/4) of the southwest quarter (SW/4). Upon approval by the Commission of this request, the undersigned will file with the Conservation Commission the appropriate papers designating the above described 93.88 acres as the proration unit allocable to the presently drilling well.

The only operators of acreage situated in the State of New Mexico offsetting the proposed unit are Leonard Oil Company and the Standard Oil Company of Texas, a Division of the Chevron Oil Company. Each has been furnished by registered mail a copy of this application.




