Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 320-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 23 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM
Section 26: E/2

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Lynn B-1 Well No. 1 located 2310 feet from the South line and 2310 feet from the East line of said Section 26.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-1670, as amended, governing the Jalmat Gas Pool, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool rules, based upon the unit size of 320 acres.
