It has been called to our attention that the non-standard gas proration unit in the Mesa Queen Pool authorized by Administrative Order NSP-756 dated June 6, 1966, comprises two separate leases and that said leases have not been approved as a communitized unit by the Commissioner of Public Lands for the State of New Mexico.

The 120-acre allowable authorized by said Order NSP-756 cannot be effective until such time as the aforesaid communitization has been approved.

Reference is made to your application for approval of a 120-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Mesa-Queen Pool consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NMPM
Section 18: S/2 NE/4 and NE/4 NE/4

It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Sinclair "A" State Well No. 1, located 2310 feet from the North line and 330 feet from the East line of said Section 18.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Order No. R-2935, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit.

A 120-acre allowable based on the above-described acreage is hereby assigned the subject well effective this date.
