Gentlemen:

We hereby request an exception to Rule 5(A) of the General Rules and Regulations for Prorated Gas Pools of Southeastern New Mexico for a non-standard proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool consisting of the SW/4, Section 14, T-26-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The proposed unit well for the non-standard proration unit will be the Tenneco Oil Company #8 Leonard Federal located 660' FSL and 660' FWL, Section 14, T-26-S, R-37-E.

The proposed non-standard proration unit:

- (1) lies wholly within a governmental section,
- (2) is a government quarter section,
- (3) contains less acreage than a standard proration unit, and
- (4) may reasonably be presumed to be productive of gas from the Jalmat Pool in its entirety.

Enclosed is a plat of the area showing the proposed non-standard proration unit outlined in red and the proposed unit well encircled in red.

A copy of this application has been furnished to Texaco and El Paso Natural Gas Company who are the only offset operators within 1500' of the proposed unit well.

Your approval of this application as soon as possible will be appreciated.
