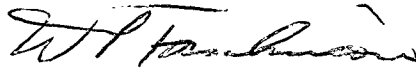

Atlantic Richfield respectfully requests administrative approval under the provisions of Order No. R-1670, Rule 29, for a 40-acre non-standard Blinbry Gas proration unit for the S. J. Sarkeys No. 3 well, located 330' FN & EL, Section 23, T-21S, R-37E, in Lea County, New Mexico. The proposed proration unit will comprise the NE/4, SE/4 of Section 23, as shown on the attached plat.

The S. J. Sarkeys No. 3 is a former oil well in the Blinbry Oil Pool. It was reclassified under R-1670, Rules 27 and 28, to Blinbry Gas as of December 1, 1970, because of a high gas-oil ratio. The well was assigned a gas allowable based upon the proposed 40-acre unit effective March 5, 1971, the date of its connection to the El Paso gathering system.

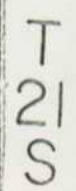
