Continental Oil Company Application for a 160 Acre NSP Unit -
Wells "A" Well No. 7, Section 1, T-25S, R-36E, Lea County, New Mexico

Continental Oil Company respectfully requests Administrative Approval under the provisions of Rule 5 (b) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool of Order No. R-1670 for approval of a 160 acre non-standard gas proration unit for its Wells "A" No. 7, located 1980' from the north line and 1980' from the west line of Section 1, T-25S, R-36E, Lea County, New Mexico in the Jalmat Gas Pool.

The unit is proposed to consist of the W/2 NW/4, SE/4 NW/4 and NE/4 SW/4 of Section 1, T-25S, R-36E. In support of this request we should like to point out that the proposed unit conforms with the requirements of Rule 5 (b) in all respects as follows:

1. Said unit consists of contiguous quarter-quarter sections and/or lots.
2. Said unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
3. The entire proposed unit may be reasonably presumed to be productive of gas.
4. The length or width of said unit does not exceed 5,280 feet.
5. Copies of this application have been furnished by certified mail to all offset operators and all operators within 1,500 feet of said well.


