Exxon requests administrative approval of a Non-Standard Proration Unit consisting of 80 acres for the New Mexico "S" State well #12. This well is located in Unit A, Section 2, T22S-R37E, Lea County, New Mexico. The present GOR for this well requires it be reclassified to a Blinebry Gas well in the Blinebry Oil and Gas Pool. 
