
Reference is made to your application dated May 12, 1997, for an 80-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit ("GPU") consisting of the following acreage in the Eumont Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM
Section 34: S/2 SW/4.

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to the existing J. H. Williams "A" Well No. 2 (API No. 30-025-05820), located at an unorthodox gas well location 330 feet from the South and West lines (Unit M) of said Section 34.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(d) of the "General Rules for the Prorated Gas Pools of New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool", as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the above-described non-standard 80-acre gas spacing and proration unit and unorthodox gas well location of the J. H. Williams "A" Well No. 2 are hereby approved. Also, Amerada Hess Corporation is hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned the subject GPU in accordance with Rule 5 of said special pool rules based upon the unit size of 80 acres.

Gentlemen:


W. K. Byrom respectfully requests administrative approval for the formation of a 160 acre non-standard gas proration unit and unorthodox location. Our J. H. Williams A No. 2 was an existing Grayburg oil well (that was temporarily abandoned) located 330 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the West line of Section 34-T19S-R37E, Lea County, New Mexico, in the Eumont Gas Pool. We have recompleted this well in the Queens sand formation; and in support of this request states:

1. The proposed non-standard unit consists of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34-T19S-R37E.
2. This unit consist of 160 acres which lies wholly within a single section.
3. The unit is productive of gas.
4. Copies of this application have been submitted to offset operators.

In view of these facts, it is requested that the Commission enter an order approving the unorthodox location and the non-standard gas proration unit for W. K. Byrom J. H. Williams A No. 2 as described above.
