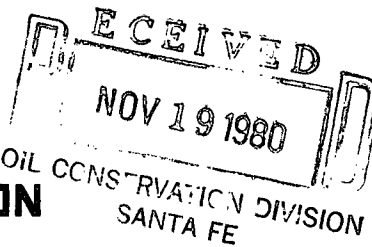

Gentlemen:

Yates Petroleum Corporation respectfully requests administrative approval for a Non-Standard gas unit described as the W $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 31, T18S, R25E, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. This unit is to be dedicated to our Penasco "IW" State Com. well No. 7 at a location 1980 feet from the south line and 660 from the west line of Section 31. The well is projected to test the Morrow at a total depth of 9,250 feet. An application for permit to drill was approved on October 17, 1980.

Administrative approval for a Non-Standard unit is sought as a result of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 31 containing 327.20 acres according to U.S. Public Land Surveys. Copies of an ownership map of the proposed unit and offset acreage are enclosed. Please advise if any additional information is required.
