



Aztec Oil & Gas Company hereby submits its application for administrative approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 29, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico, and in support thereof respectfully states and shows the following:

1. That the Aztec-Holder No. 1 Well, located 1980 feet from the North line and 1780 feet from the West line of Section 29, Township 30 North, Range 12 West, was completed on November 13, 1946 as a gas well and connected to Southern Union Gas Company's pipeline on November 18, 1946.
2. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit consists of 40 acres which is a quarter-quarter section.
3. That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.




