This letter constitutes an application for administrative approval of the above non-standard proration unit and unorthodox location for Lewis B. Burleson, Inc.

The NE/4 Section 35 is currently non-producing, but was previously dedicated to ARCO Oil and Gas Company's McDonald WN State No. 7 (A-35-22S-37E) which is a Jalmat (Gas) well that last produced in September, 1975. Upon the drilling and completion of the Lewis Burleson State 32 No. 1, that well will be dedicated to the previously existing 160-acre proration unit consisting of NE/4 Section 35. Therefore, we hereby file for administrative approval to dedicate the new infill well, Lewis Burleson State 32 No. 1 to the previously existing, but currently non-productive, non-standard Jalmat (Gas) proration unit consisting of NE/4 Section 35, T22S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico.





We request permission to drill a well 860' FNL & 660' FEL of Section 35, T-22-S, R-36-E, Lea County as a non-standard location on this 160 acre non-standard unit. We request to drill this well on this location for geological reasons as outlined below and for topographic and pipeline reasons as this location had to be moved from a 660' footage from the north line as per our original application to drill. We found in staking this well there are five pipelines crossing our first location so the furthest north we could drill a well was at a 860' from the north spot.

Attached is a contour map on top of the main Yates porosity which shows a rather flat area with a structural buildup on the east of our proposed NE/4 160 acre tract. We have picked a location in this high structural area to make sure that we have a place for best drainage and largest gas reserve to protect the correlative rights of this state lease.

The attached cross-section, A-A', the line of which is shown in blue on this map shows the cleanest and most productive sands located in the vicinity of the Ohio State McDonald 1-B # 5, or well 405. The wells to the west, being the 1 "B" no. 2, or well 402, shows a thinner and slightly more shaley Yates sand than in the vicinity of our proposed location.

Therefore, the geological cross-section dictates a location in the NE/4 of our 160 acre tract.

Since all of the 160 acre units surrounding our well in the NE/4 of Section 35 are productive we request that you grant your approval of this 660'-860' location.
