Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for a 160-acre non-standard proration unit consisting of the S/2 NW/4 and the N/2 SW/4 of Section 29, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Also, you are hereby authorized to simultaneously dedicate this proration unit to your A. B. Reeves Well No. 1 located 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit L) and your A. B. Reeves Well No. 2 located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit E), both in said Section 29 and both located at standard locations. Further, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable from any of the wells on the proration unit in any proportion.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 5(C) of Order No. R-1670, the above non-standard proration unit is hereby approved.
