Reference is made to your application on behalf of Dwight A. Tipton for an 80-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the High Plains-Permo Pennsylvanian Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, NMPM
Section 22: E/2 SE/4

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to the Sunset International Petroleum Corporation Union State Well No. 1, plugged and abandoned June, 1967, located at an unorthodox location 2086 feet from the South line and  $\overline{766}$  feet from the East line (Unit I) of said Section 22, which is to be re-entered to test the Pennsylvanian formation, is hereby approved under provisions of Rule 5 of Division Order No. R-2874, as amended.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 3 of said Order No. R-2874, as amended , the above non-standard proration unit is hereby approved.
