Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for a 160-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the South Peterson Pennsylvanian Associated Pool:

ROOSEVELT COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 6 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM
Section 11: NE/4

It is my understanding that this unit is to be simultaneously dedicated to your Bledsoe Well No. 1 located 1874 feet from the North line and 766 feet from the East line (Unit H) of said Section 11 and to your Bledsoe Well No. 2 located at an unorthodox gas well location 500 feet from the North line and 700 feet from the East line (Unit A) of said Section 11. The unorthodox gas well location for said Bledsoe Well No. 2 is hereby approved under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of Division Order No. R-5353, as amended. Further, you are hereby permitted to produce the allowable assigned to said unit from both wells in any proportion.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 4(b) of Division Order No. R-5353, as amended, the above non-standard proration unit is hereby approved.
