Reference is made to your application for a 20.58-acre non-standard oil proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Brushy Draw Delaware Pool:

Section 35: Lot 9:

Said non-standard unit is due to variations in the legal subdivision of the U.S. Public Land Surveys along the New Mexico - Texas state line.

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your Stateline Federal Well No. 2 located at a previously approved unorthodox oil well location 610 feet from the South line and 990 feet from the West line (Unit E) of said Section 35. (see NSL-2450)
