Reference is made to your application of July 5, 1988 and September 20, 1988 for a 103.44-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of Lots 1 and 2 and the E/2 NW/4 of Irregular Section 19, Township 30 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, Undesignated Blanco Fruitland Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, to be dedicated to your Mansfield Com Well No. 250 to be drilled at an unorthodox gas well location 1420 feet from the North line and 1190 feet from the West line (Unit F) of said Section 19.
