Reference is made to your application of July 15, 1988 and October 20, 1988 for an 83.10-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Undesignated Blanco Fruitland Pool:

SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO  
TOWNSHIP 30 NORTH, RANGE 8 WEST, NMPM  
Irregular Section 31: Lots 15, 16, 17 and 18

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your Howell "M" Well No. 300 to be drilled at an unorthodox gas well location 1590 feet from the South line and 875 feet from the West line of said Section 31.
