Reference is made to your application on behalf of Southland Royalty Company on October 10, 1989, for a 314.78-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool:

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your Trail Canyon Well No. 100 to be drilled at a previously authorized unorthodox coal gas well location, pursuant to Decretory Paragraph No. (4) of Division Order No. R-8768, 1790 feet from the South line and 810 feet from the East line (Unit I) of said Section 7.
