Reference is made to your applications of October 7, 1989 and December 11, 1989 for a non-standard 351.89 acre gas proration unit comprising all of Irregular Section 6, Township 31 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your Northeast Blanco Unit Well No. 426 to be drilled at an unorthodox coal gas well location 1730 feet from the South line and 740 feet from the West line (Unit L) of said Section 6, hereby approved under provisions of Rule 8 of the Special Rules and Regulations for this pool as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768.

Also, by authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 6 of said Order No. R-8768, the above non-standard gas proration unit is hereby approved.
