
Reference is made to your applications of February 5, 1990 and April 12, 1990 for a 313.60-acre non-standard gas proration unit consisting of the following acreage:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO  
TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM  
Section 4: Lots 1 through 8

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your O.C. Federal Com Well No. 1 to be drilled at an unorthodox gas well location 640 feet from the North line and 1830 feet from the West line (Unit C) of said Section 4, to test the Devonian, Silurian and Ellenburger formations.

By authority granted me under the provisions of General Rules 104.D.II. and 104.F.I., the above-described non-standard gas proration unit and unorthodox gas well location are hereby approved.
