We may not process the subject application for a non-standard gas proration unit until the required information or plat(s) checked below are submitted.

- A plat must be submitted clearly showing the ownership of the offsetting leases.
- A statement must be submitted that offset operators have been notified of the application by certified mail.
- A plat must be submitted fully identifying the topography necessitating the non-standard location.
- Other: It appears that this well is at an unorthodox location because of its distance from the East boundary of the proposed proration unit. Also, our records indicate that the proposed proration unit comprising Lots 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7, the SE/4 NW/4, and E/2 SW/4 of Section 6 consist of 199.00 acres. Where are the acreage figures shown on your C-102 from?






