Reference is made to your application dated March 9, 1992 for a 40.40-acre non-standard oil proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Baum - Upper Pennsylvanian Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 32 EAST, NMPM
Section 2: Lot 1 (NE/4 NE/4 equivalent)

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your Baum 704-JD-D Well No. 1 located at a standard oil well location 660 feet from the North line and 510 feet from the East line (Unit A) of said Section 2.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 3 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Baum - Upper Pennsylvanian Pool, as promulgated by Division Order R-3368-A, you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described acreage as a non-standard oil proration unit, with allowable to be assigned thereto in accordance with Rule 6 of said pool rules based upon the unit size of 40.40 acres.
