Reference is made to your application on behalf of the operator Lanexco, Inc. by letter dated September 23, 1992 for an unorthodox Jalmat gas well location in an existing non-standard 440-acre gas spacing and proration unit (GPU) for said Jalmat Gas Pool comprising the NW/4 NW/4, S/2 NW/4, and S/2 of Section 33, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Said GPU was authorized by Division Order No. R-687, dated September 15, 1955 and had dedicated thereon the El Paso Tom Federal Well No. 6 located at a standard gas well location 1650 feet from the South and East lines (Unit J) of said Section 33.

By Division Order No. R-6511, dated November 6, 1980, an additional well recompleted to the Jalmat Gas Pool from the Langlie - Mattix Pool, the El Paso Tom Federal Well No. 7 (formerly the Gregory "A" Federal Well No. 2), located at an unorthodox gas well location 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit L) of said Section 33 was approved for said GPU.

By Division Order No. R-6511-A, dated November 2, 1983, a third well to be drilled and completed in the subject GPU was approved for the El Paso Tom Federal Well No. 5 located at an unorthodox gas well location 1650 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the West line (Unit E) of said Section 33.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(c) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, the following described well to be drilled at an unorthodox gas well location is hereby approved:

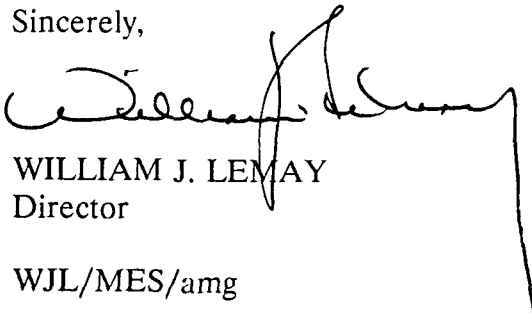

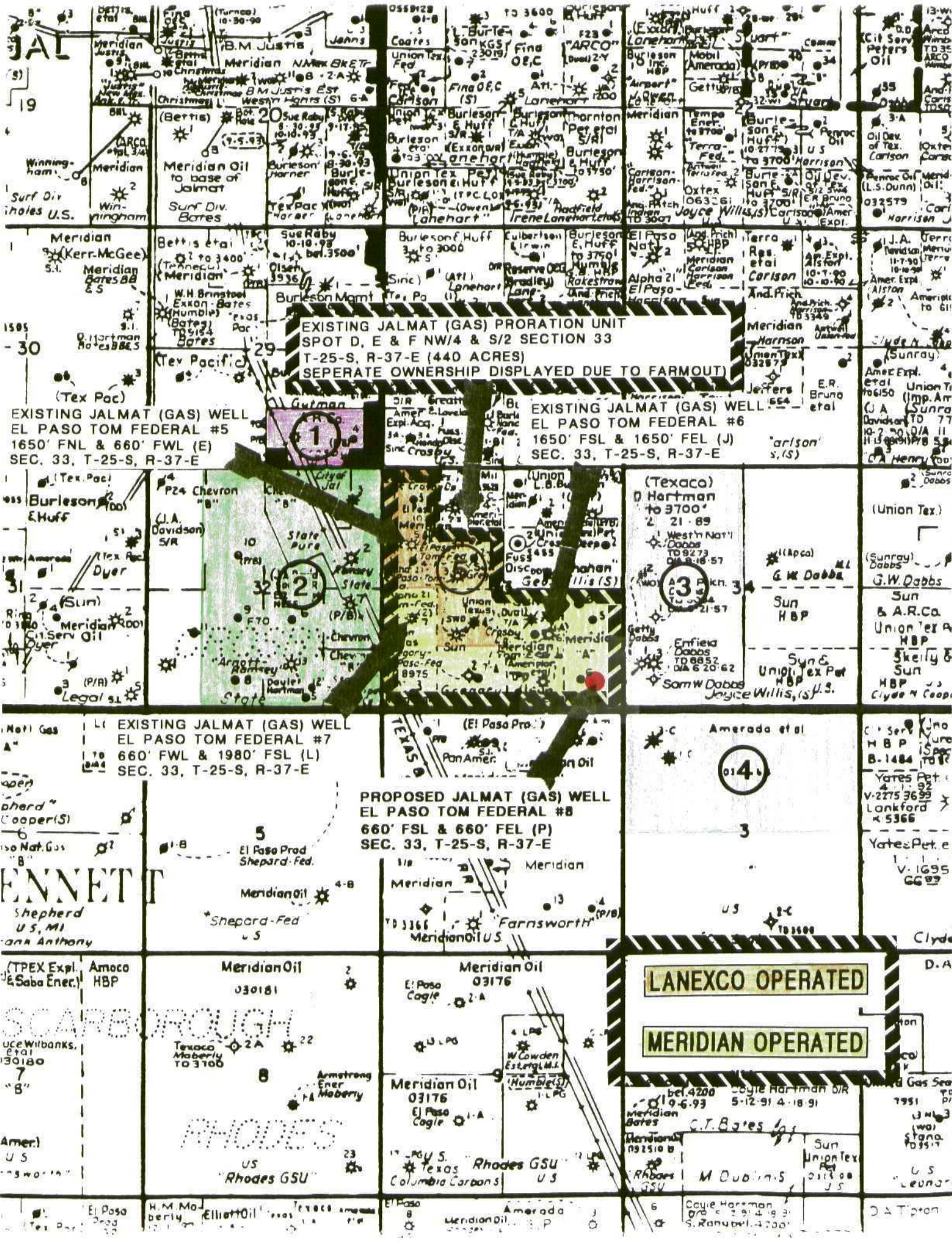

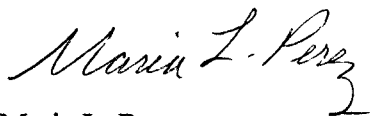

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to the attached notification from Meridian Oil dated September 23, 1992, and first received by Hartman on November 9, 1992, regarding Meridian's application for an unorthodox location and simultaneous dedication of the above-referenced well. We were dismayed to learn that NMOCD Order NSL-3172 (SD) dated October 30, 1992 has already approved an unorthodox location of 660' FSL and 660' FEL, Section 33, T-25-S, R-37-E for Meridian's El Paso Tom Federal No. 8 well and simultaneously dedicated it along with the El Paso Tom Federal Nos. 5, 6 and 7 wells to the existing 440-acre non-standard Jalmat (Gas) proration unit consisting of the NW/4 and S/2 of Section 33, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Hartman has no record of receiving a copy of this Administrative Application from Meridian prior to November 9, 1992, and to date, Meridian has not supplied evidence that it was sent to us by certified mail on September 23, 1992, as stated in their Application.

As a direct offset to Hartman's Dabbs No. 3 well (M-34-25S-37E), we are concerned about an unorthodox location for Meridian's El Paso Tom Federal No. 8 that is 330' nearer to our lease line than allowed by Jalmat (Gas) pool rules which allow for a standard location of 990' from any boundary line for a 440-acre non-standard proration unit. We agree that Meridian has the right to develop and profit from the leasehold interest they own, however, we are concerned about being encroached upon. In light of this, we have no objection to the drilling of Meridian's El Paso Tom Federal No. 8 and its subsequent simultaneous

dedication to the existing 440-acre non-standard Jalmat (Gas) proration unit, so long as the location of the No. 8 well is at least 990' from our lease line as outlined in the Jalmat (Gas) Pool rules and regulations.

Reference is made to the attached notifications from Meridian Oil dated November 30, 1992 and December 1, 1992, and received by Hartman on December 1, 1992 and December 2, 1992, respectively. Meridian proposes to reduce their original non-standard Jalmat (Gas) proration unit from its current 440-acres, which consists of the S/2, S/2 NW/4 and NW/4 NW/4 of Section 33, T-25-S, R-37-E. In doing so, the previously proposed well, the El Paso Tom Federal No. 8, to be drilled at a location of 660' FSL and 660' FEL of Section 33, T-25-S, R-37-E, would become a standard location.

Meridian has requested that their existing El Paso Tom Federal No. 7 well (L-33-25S-37E) be dedicated to their proposed 120-acre non-standard Jalmat (Gas) proration unit consisting of the S/2 SW/4 and NW/4 SW/4 of Section 33. Reference is made to the attached notification from Meridian Oil dated September 23, 1992, and first received by Hartman on November 9, 1992, regarding Meridian's application for an unorthodox location and simultaneous dedication of the above-referenced well. We were dismayed to learn that NMOCD Order NSL-3172 (SD) dated October 30, 1992 has already approved an unorthodox location of 660' FSL and 660' FEL, Section 33, T-25-S, R-37-E for Meridian's El Paso Tom Federal No. 8 well and simultaneously dedicated it along with the El Paso Tom Federal Nos. 5, 6 and 7 wells to the existing 440-acre non-standard Jalmat (Gas) proration unit consisting of the NW/4 and S/2 of Section 33, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. Hartman has no record of receiving a copy of this Administrative Application from Meridian prior to November 9, 1992, and to date, Meridian has not supplied evidence that it was sent to us by certified mail on September 23, 1992, as stated in their Application.

As a direct offset to Hartman's Dabbs No. 3 well (M-34-25S-37E), we are concerned about an unorthodox location for Meridian's El Paso Tom Federal No. 8 that is 330' nearer to our lease line than allowed by Jalmat (Gas) pool rules which allow for a standard location of 990' from any boundary line for a 440-acre non-standard proration unit. We agree that Meridian has the right to develop and profit from the leasehold interest they own, however, we are concerned about being encroached upon. In light of this, we have no objection to the drilling of Meridian's El Paso Tom Federal No. 8 and its subsequent simultaneous

dedication to the existing 440-acre non-standard Jalmat (Gas) proration unit, so long as the location of the No. 8 well is at least 990' from our lease line as outlined in the Jalmat (Gas) Pool rules and regulations.
