Reference is made to your application dated April 20, 1993 for a 160-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Atoka gas producing formation:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM
Section 9: SW/4

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your existing Graham Well No. 1 located 2310 feet from the South line and 430 feet from the West line (Unit L) of said Section 9, which could be considered a non-standard gas well location pursuant to Division General Rule 104.B(1)..

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 104.F(1) and 104.D(2), the above non-standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit is hereby approved.
