Reference is made to your application March 11, 1994 for a 160-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Eumont Gas Pool:

LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM
Section 29: N/2 S/2


It is my understanding that this unit is to be simultaneously dedicated to the existing Eumont Gas Com 2 Well Nos. 1 and 2, respectively, located at standard gas well locations 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the East line (Unit I) and 1980 feet from the South and West lines (Unit K) of said Section 29.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 2(a)4 of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Eumont Gas Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8170, as amended, you are hereby authorized to operate the above non-standard gas spacing and proration unit, with allowable assigned thereto in accordance with Rule 5 of said pool rules based upon the unit size of 160 acres.

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The current 320-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit comprising the S/2 of said Section 29, currently dedicated to both wells under authority of Division Order No. R-854, dated August 10, 1965, shall be terminated upon issuance of this order. Further, said Order R-854 shall be placed in abeyance until further notice.
