
Reference is made to your application dated March 28, 1994, as amended by letter dated May 24, 1994, for an 80-acre non-standard gas spacing and proration unit consisting of the following acreage in the Bluitt-San Andres Associated Pool:

ROOSEVELT COUNTY, NEW MEXICO
TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM
Section 17: E/2 SE/4

It is my understanding that this unit is to be dedicated to your existing Federal "17-A" Well No. 2 located at an unorthodox gas well location 660 feet from the South line and 810 feet from the East line (Unit P) of said Section 17.

By authority granted me under the provisions of Rules 2(c) and 4(b) of the General Rules and Regulations for the Associated Oil and Gas Pools of Northwest and Southeast New Mexico/Special Rules and Regulations for the Bluitt-San Andres Associated Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-5353, as amended, the above unorthodox gas well location and non-standard gas spacing and proration unit are hereby approved.
