(2) Gulf's Mark Well No. 3, located 190 feet from the north and
east lines of this Section 3, and
it is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to
your Mark Well No. 7, located 760 feet from the East line
and 1900 feet from the North line of said Section 3.

By authority granted me under the provisions of the
Special Rules and Regulations for the Blinbry Gas Pool,
you are hereby authorized to operate the above-described
acreage as a non-standard gas proration unit, with allow-
able to be assigned thereto in accordance with the pool
rules, based upon the unit size of 120 acres.
