IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:


(1) That Paragraph (4) on Page 2 of Order No. R-111-N,  
be and the same is hereby corrected to read in its entirety  
as follows:

"(4) That, based upon the evidence submitted at  
the hearing, it is not established that the E/2 NW/4  
of Section 7, Township 19 South, Range 31 East, NMPM,  
Eddy County, New Mexico, contains commercial deposits  
of potash and the application for inclusion of said  
lands in the Oil-Potash Area should be denied."
