
ORDER OF THE COMMISSION GRANTING

THIS MATTER having come before the Oil Conservation Commission on Marshall & Winston, Inc.'s Motion for Continuance ("Motion"), Case Nos. 14538 and 14497 having been combined by Order No. R-13372 for purposes of hearing, pursuant to 19.15.4.16.C NMAC, the Chair of the Commission FINDS that the Motion is well considered and for good cause shown should be granted.
