ORDER OF THE COMMISSION


THIS MATTER came before the Oil Conservation Commission ("Commission") on the request of DCP Midstream, LP ("DCP") to correct a clerical error in a factual finding in Order No. R-13809. The Chair of the Commission, having reviewed the request and finding that it is well taken, orders that Finding #6 in the Order be replaced with the following paragraph:

6. The Zia AGI No. 1 well will have a surface location approximately 2100 feet from the South line and 950 feet from the West line and a bottom-hole location approximately 2580 feet from the North line and 950 feet from the West line of said Section 19. The Zia AGI No. 2 well will have a surface location approximately 1900 feet from the South line and 950 feet from the West line and a bottom-hole location approximately 1590 feet from the South line and 1400 feet from the West line of said Section 19.

All other provisions in Order No. R-13809 remain in full force and in effect.
