ORDER ON UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR STAY


THIS MATTER came before the Oil Conservation Commission ("Commission") on the Unopposed Motion of Jalapeno Corporation and Yates Energy Corporation ("Jalapeno") requesting that the Commission stay consideration of Jalapeno's Application for Hearing De Novo filed October 22, 2015 pending a decision by the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") on the merits of the force pooling application of Matador Production Company ("Matador"). Matador concurs in this Motion. The Division has no objection. The Commission FINDS that good cause exists for granting the Motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Jalapenos' Application for Hearing De Novo is stayed pending a decision by the Division on the merits of Matador's force pooling application. Within thirty (30) days of issuance of the Division's Order on the force pooling application, the parties shall either move to lift the stay and request a setting on all pending de novo applications or advise the Commission that a hearing is no longer necessary.
