ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

(1) On April 2 and April 16, 2015, this case was heard by examiners and Order No. R-14004 was entered on July 14, 2015, denying COG's application.

(2) On July 22, 2015, COG, through its counsel, filed a timely application for De Novo hearing. The De Novo application was originally set for hearing before the Oil Conservation Commission on September 10, 2015. After several continuances, the application was scheduled for the February 11, 2016 Commission Meeting.


(3) On January 28, 2016, COG counsel requested that the De Novo case be dismissed.
