PROCEDURAL ORDER

HEARING:

RULES OF PROCEDURE

This proceeding is governed by the Geothermal Resources Conservation Act, NMSA 1978, Sections 71-5-1 et seq. ("Act"), and the rules promulgated under that Act, 19.14 NMAC ("Rules"). This Order is intended to supplement the Act and the Rules. The Commission may also rely on the rule for adjudicatory proceedings under the Oil and Gas Act, 19.15.4 NMAD, as guidelines. The Rules of Civil Procedure do not apply to this proceeding.

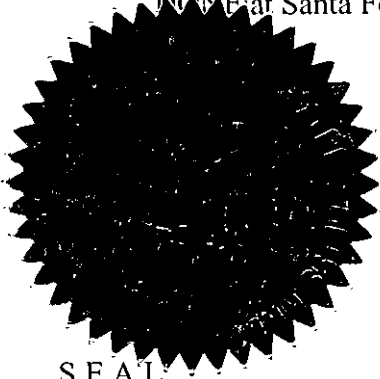
FILING OF PROPOSED FINDINGS

All parties shall file Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law with the Commission at the beginning of the hearing on October 7, 2015.

CLOSING STATEMENTS

Closing statements will be made at the conclusion of the hearing. Lightning Dock and AmeriCulture will be allowed 30 minutes for their closing. The Oil Conservation Division and the Hidalgo County Soil & Water Conservation District will be allowed 15 minutes for their closing.
