TO RETURN FOUR WELLS TO COMPLIANCE WITH 19.15.4.201 NMAC BY A DATE CERTAIN AND, IN THE EVENT OF NON-COMPLIANCE, AUTHORIZING THE DIVISION TO PLUG SAID WELLS AND FORFEIT THE APPLICABLE FINANCIAL ASSURANCE, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

BY THE DIVISION:

(1) Due public notice has been given, and the Division has jurisdiction of this case and its subject matter.


