NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

BY THE DIVISION:

It appears to the Oil Conservation Division that Order No. R-12458, dated November 21, 2005, does not correctly state the intended order of the Division.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) Ordering Paragraph No. (a) on page 2 of Order No. R-12458 is replaced with the following:

(a) A new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico classified as an oil pool for Grayburg-San Andres production is hereby created and designated as the High Lonesome-Grayburg-San Andres Pool (**Pool Code 97479**), consisting of the following described area:


TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 29 EAST, NMPM
Section 16: SE/4

(2) The corrections set forth in this order shall be entered nunc pro tunc as of November 21, 2005.

(3) Except as modified hereby, Order No. R-12458 shall remain in full force and effect.

(4) Jurisdiction is retained for the entry of such further orders as may be necessary.
