**ORDER ON COG'S MOTION TO QUASH
AND BURNETT/HUDSON'S MOTION TO COMPEL**

THIS MATTER came before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for hearing on April 7, 2011 at Santa Fe, New Mexico on competing motions relative to discovery. The Division Director having reviewed the respective Motions, having considered the recommendation of the hearing examiner, and being otherwise advised, finds and orders as follows:


1. The parties advised that they have resolved their differences with respect to two of the three requests which are the subject of the competing motions, being Request Nos. 1 and 2 of the Second Subpoena. Thus, the competing Motions with respect to these requests are moot, and no ruling is required of the Division.

2. As to the third request, being Request No. 8 of the First Subpoena, the Division finds the request is not relevant and should be quashed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

COG's Motion to Quash is GRANTED with respect to Request 8 of the First Subpoena and Burnett/Hudson's competing Motion to Compel on that request is DENIED.
