Dear Mr. Parsell:

We do not have any address for Peter Siemens. The only information I can give you is that his partner, Dave H. Boyd, resided in Samora, New Mexico. However, as this was some time ago, you may not be able to locate him either.

The Commission will be holding a hearing on April 5 to determine whether this well should be ordered to be plugged and abandoned. The Fidelity and Casualty Co. of New York will be receiving formal notice soon. Please note that once a well has been ordered plugged, the surety becomes liable, as well as the principal, for the plugging. Otherwise, the bond must be forfeited. As an order could not be issued for some time, however, you should have ample opportunity both to locate your principal and your file.
