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Mr. Harold J. Sechler filed Notice of Intention to Drill a well to be known as Bond, Well No. 1 located in Unit G Section 17, Township 9 North, Range 14 West, NMPM, Valencia County, New Mexico. This office approved said notice January 12, 1961. As no further reports, pertaining to this well, had been received an inspection of the location was made to determine the status of the well. The condition of the area surrounding the well site indicates a well had been drilled and the regulation marker indicates the well to be plugged.

Mr. Harold J. Sechler was supplied with a copy of the Rules and Regulations of the New Mexico Oil Conservation and his attention was directed to forms required by the Commission for wells drilled for the purpose of exploration for Oil and/or Gas. Inasmuch as these rules and regulations have been ignored and the well plugged without benefit of a prescribed plugging program, you are hereby notified that all delinquent forms, including your plugging program, shall be forwarded to this office within 15 days after receipt of this letter.

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If the requested forms are not received within 15 days the Surety Company will be called upon to re-enter Bond Well No. 1, clean out to total depth and plug the well in a manner prescribed by this office.
