## Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of May 17, 1960, requesting a plugging program for the subject well and for names and addresses of contractors in this area with whom I have had experience.

It is difficult to outline an exact plugging program for the subject well as from the recent inspection of a well it was impossible to determine anything other than the well is flowing salt water. If the well is in the condition as indicated by the latest reports filed by Byron Gore on July 15, 1958, it will only be necessary to clean out (if necessary) to a depth of 450 feet, fill the well with heavy mud of the type used in plugging, spot a 25 sack cement plug at 250 feet and a 10 sack plug at the surface. A marker of 4-inch diameter should be set in the top plug and shall extend 4 feet above ground level.

In a letter directed to you dated April 7, 1960, pertaining to the plugging of the Hawaiian-New Mexkco Oil Ventures Well No. 1, Mr. O. E. Payne listed the names and addresses of a few drilling
