Dear Mr. Buttram:

It appears that drilling operations have been suspended on the subject well for some time. I therefore call your attention to Rule 202, paragraph (c) Commission Rules and Regulations which states, "When drilling operations have been suspended for 60 days, the well shall be plugged and abandoned unless a permit for temporary abandonment shall be obtained from the Commission." Further, I call your attention to Rules 1100, 1105, 1106 and 1108 which rules deal with the filing of Commission forms. You have to date filed only a notice of intention to drill and the Commission expects to receive an immediate report on all work done on the subject well.
