We have been very lenient with the principal, Hawaiian-New Mexico Oil Ventures, regarding the well in Section 27, Township 7 North, Range 4 West, Valencia County, New Mexico. The result has been violation of Commission Rules and Regulations and a disregard of our correspondence and demands.

We will allow the principal until midnight October 9, 1959, to resume operations. If operations have not been actively resumed by that date, the well must be properly plugged no later than December 31, 1959, by your Company, as surety, or by the principal.
