Gentlemen:

In an attempt to close our files on wells which are being carried as "active", and which are known or suspected as abandoned, we would appreciate your review of the following:

Moore Well No. 1, Unit D, Sec. 10, T-29-N, R-24-E  
Moore Well No. 2, Unit L, Sec. 10, T-29-N, R-24-E  
Moore Well No. 3, Unit P, Sec. 8, T-29-N, R-24-E  
Burns Well No. 1, Unit M, Sec. 34, T-17-N, R-36-E

The first two of the above described locations are known to have been plugged and abandoned and your reports of such plugging are in our files. The status of the latter two locations is unknown, but it appears they may have been abandoned without drilling.

In the case of those wells which were drilled (or re-entered) we need completion reports (Form C-105), logs, and notification that the locations have been cleared and levelled. (See Rule 202-A) In the case of locations permitted but not drilled - and no plans now for drilling - a cancellation should be filed. (C-103, Change Plans)
