We must advise again that this office does not handle rentals or any of the points involved in your request. If the well is on a State lease, you might refer your request to the State Land Office, Santa Fe; if it is on privately owned land, the information would have to be obtained from the landowner.

A check of well records shows that the landowner at one time was the Tex-Mex Cattle Company of Wichita Falls, Texas. However, no forms have been filed within recent years, and we are not sure how current this information may be.

Our inspector for the district involved will check the location, and we will advise you of the status of the well.
