Dear Mr Horn:-

For your information we did not make any further progress in getting the tools out after you was here, our boiler went bad and we are going to install an other one 1st of next week.

I was at the well southeast of Wagon Mound tuesday, they have moved the tools and drilling outfit away as thought they have quit the job.

There is a terrible rouring in the cellar as though a large amount of gas was escaping through the valves I should think this should be seen about.

When we get going again will let you know but am afraid we have a job on hand getting the tools out.
