the ranch owned by Mr. Frank Sauble near Springer, New Mexico.

The Sauble No. 2 well was plugged and abandoned with suitable
marker placed on the surface as called for by the Rules and Re-
gulations of the Oil Conservation Commission. The No. 3 well
was cement plugged at its lower depth and then mud filled and
left for the land owner's conversion to a water well. Mr. Sauble
was in complete accord with the above operations by Mr. Clyde
Neill.
