On your report you carried it as 660 from the south line and 1980° from the east line of Sec. 13, T. 30N., R. 22E. The question is which location is correct.

Second - the #3 St. Louis etc. According to the plat this well is in Range 22 East. Your report carried it as Range 21 East. Once again - which location is correct?

If we can get these two problems straightened out I promise to never mention these wells to you again.

I haven't heard yet if we are to keep the forms C-101 and C-105 you sent us or send them back to you.
